



Fresh (Square) Strawberry Pie

Mix & Pat in bottom of sprayed 9 x 13 pan:

2 C. Flour

2 Tbs. sugar

34 C. melted butter

Bake at 350 for 12-15 min (lightly browned). Cool.

Glaze: 1 1/2 C. sugar

3 Tbs. cornstarch (mix with sugar before adding

water)

1 ½ C cold water

Heat in microwave until bubbly thick- stirring every 1-2 min. It will take about 5 minutes.

After it is thick, remove from heat and add:

3 oz. strawberry jello-dry

3 Tbs. butter

1 tsp. vanilla

Few drops red food color

Cool a bit and stir in 3 pts. fresh strawberries, cut up. Pour onto crust and refrigerate.

Serve with whipped cream or ice cream.

2 chopped tomatoes (drain if extra liquid)

½ C. lettuce (can use shreds or leaf)

Mix cream cheese and mayo in bowl until smooth. Add chopped tomatoes and bacon crumbles. Spread on tortillas. Top with lettuce and roll tightly. Cut into slices to show as a spiral.
