Combining Efforts

BLANCHARD VALLEY AND DESHLER COOPS TURN TO AGVANTAGE FOR SOFTWARE

When the merger of the Blanchard Valley Farmers Cooperative (BVFC) of Findlay, OH, and Deshler Farmers Cooperative of Deshler, OH, takes effect in March 2014 as the newly-formed Legacy Farmers Cooperative, their combined operations will be using AgVantage® Software.

Jamie Pratt, IT systems manager at BVFC, says after looking at a couple of other companies, it was decided to convert Deshler's software to AgVantage programs. BVFC has 1,835 members and Deshler has 650.

"AgVantage is as progressive as any company in the industry," says Pratt, who has been BVFC's IT manager for four years.

BVCF has used AgVantage software for more than 20 years, Pratt says, going back to the days when the company was known as Udenberg & Associates, Inc.

The merger, which was approved July 10, will add Deshler's two grain and one agronomy locations.

Making The Transition

Although Deshler uses another software system, AgVantage previously has managed transitions from that system to AgVantage's programs so it has experience in making the change, Pratt states.

AgVantage products are easy to use and learn, he notes. "We'll show the Deshler employees how to click a couple buttons, and they'll be printing grain tickets," Pratt says. "We have a great agronomy program from AgVantage, too, and we will transfer that to the Deshler operations."

Although BVFC has diverse operations, it utilizes AgVantage programs for everything. The BVFC lawn and pet store uses AgVantage's PC invoicing. It also uses software that allows the coop's employees to clock in and out on the computer or on their mobile device. "It's pretty convenient," says Pratt.

The PC agronomy and PC grain scale programs are the main programs that BVFC uses. "We will be able to implement our grain scale program at the Deshler locations," Pratt explains. "It will give us the flexibility to do that."

AgVantage's technical support is provided by experts who know the ins and outs of the software programs. "They have experts in all of the areas, so you can rely on different experts," Pratt says.

BVFC is looking at adding AgVantage programs being developed for seed sales and customer management that will tie all the divisions together.
